- Confirmation of a successful application will only be given to the contact named on the bid form (INT-01) overleaf.
- Only applications in the correct adult to child ratio will be accepted.
- The deadline for receipt of bid forms (INT-01) is **31 January 2010** and late bid forms will only be accepted after this date at the discretion of the Centenary Camp team.
