



## Catch the Moment Competition Rules

Please also refer to the competition Terms and Conditions

### All photos/films must:

- Capture a 'Centenary Moment'.
- Have been taken/filmed during the Centenary Year- 5 September 2009 and October 20 2010.
- Be entered by the closing date 20.11.10
- Be named
- State the date when the photo/film was taken.
- State the name of the photographers unit.
- Include a short description (no more than 150 words) of the Centenary Moment.
- Include a statement from the entrant (if over 18) or entrant's leader (under 18) that the relevant Girlguiding UK photo permission forms have been completed by the parents/carers of any young person under the age of 16.

### Entrants must:

- Be members of Girlguiding UK.
- State their D.O.B.
- Ensure that everyone in the photo gave their permission for the photo to be taken. See below.
- Select their best photos- each member can submit up to 25 images. The first 25 images received will be those judged.
- Professional photographers cannot enter.

### Entrants under 18:

- Entrants under the age of 18 must ask a Girlguiding UK appointed Leader to enter the photos on their behalf. This is to ensure the child protection requirements of the photos are met.
- Leaders must state that they hold the relevant Girlguiding UK photo permissions forms from the parents of any person under the age of 16 featured in the photos entered.
- If the photo does not contain any person under the age of 16 in the photo, then the member under 16 can submit the photo themselves by sending it on CD using the CD submission form.

### Entrants over 18:

- Are responsible for ensuring that they have the relevant Girlguiding UK photo permission forms from the parents of any young person featured in the photo. If this is held by another leader they should state the name of the leader in the description of the photo.
- It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure this permission is in place.

### Senior Section members age 18+:

- Can choose to enter each photo into the Senior Section category or Adult category. The same photo cannot be entered into two categories.
- In total only 25 photos may be submitted.

### Photos taken at Events:

- At many large scale events photo permission is acquired from members on applications to attend the event.
- Check with event organizers to ensure that this is in place.
- Photos taken at these events can be submitted with a note that the photo permission was acquired as part of the event.



## Competition Judging Process

- All photos/films will be moderated by Girlguiding UK and any deemed inappropriate removed.
- A selection of 100 in each category will be judged by each Country and Region.
- Each Country and Region will select their top 10 images/films in each category.
- Girlguiding UK judge the top 100 images/films from each of the 10 Countries and Regions. A winner and a runner up will be selected in each category.
- The winners of the photo categories will be hosted on line and an open vote will be held in spring 2011 for the overall competition winner.

The plan for the Judging is:

Country and Region Judging panel will be made up of:

- Chief Commissioner or nominated representative.
- CHQ project contact (Regional volunteer set up to liaise on this project)
- Country or Regional PRA.
- Local contact with expertise in photography and/or film.
- Local person of interest who is related to the media e.g. photographer, radio presenter, TV star etc.

Girlguiding UK's Judging Panel will be made up of:

- The Chief Guide or nominated representative.
- Two volunteers aged under 26.
- An in-house photography expert
- A special celebrity guest judge (TBC).

The prizes are:

Competition winner as voted by members of Girlguiding UK:

£500 of Jessop's gift vouchers.

Their photo will feature on the front cover of *guiding* magazine.

6 categories winners will each win\*:

£250 of Jessop's gift vouchers.

Framed and mounted copy of their winning photo

A photo shoot for you and your guiding friends to become 'cover girls' for Girlguiding UK in 2011.

*\*One of the 6 categories is film they will not win a framed photo.*

6 runners up each winning:

£25 of Jessop's gift vouchers.

All prizes will be awarded by 1 May 2011, entrants must maintain their Flickr account they will be notified via email to this account if they have won.

Girlguiding UK:

- Will not acknowledge applications or chase their receipt.
- All applications will be hosted on the Catch the Moment Flickr Group and members can monitor that they have been successfully entered via this website.
